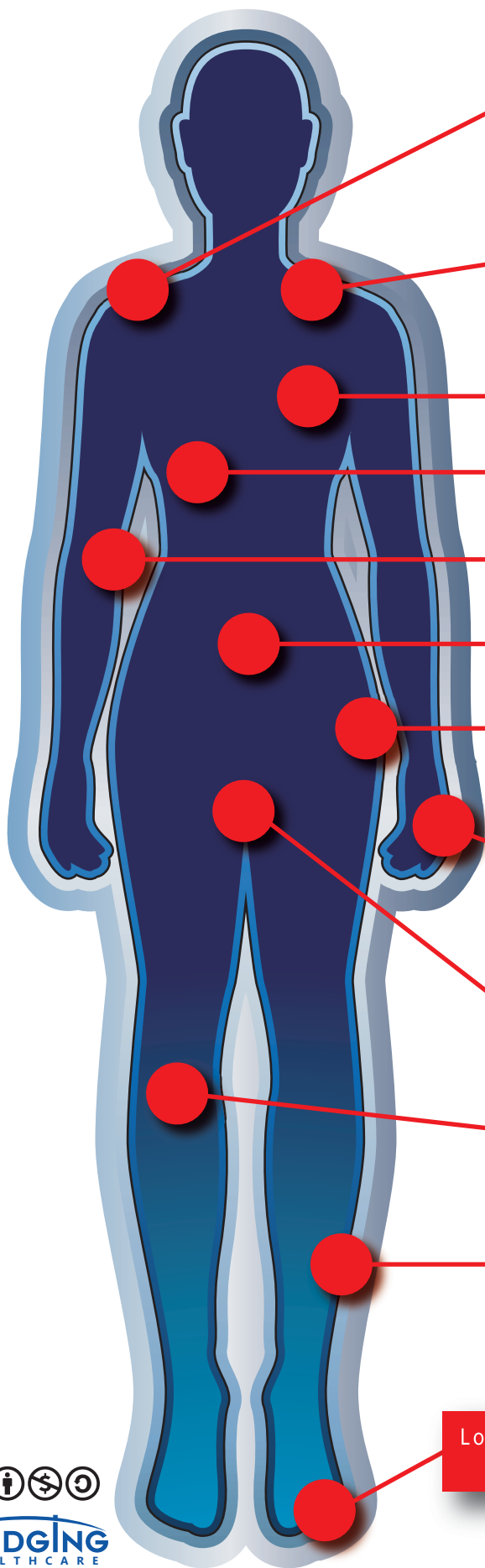


Diagnostic Ultrasonography Available to Private Sector Nurse Practitioners



Shoulder or Upper Arm*

⊕ Only available if suspected injury to tendon, muscle or muscle/tendon junction, rotator cuff tear, subluxation of biceps, mass, occult fracture, or AC joint pathology.

Interventional Musculoskeletal US*

⊕ Only available when request states that US-guided intervention be performed only if clinically indicated.

Breast

Chest or Abdominal Wall

Forearm or Elbow

Abdomen

Hip*, Groin, Buttock or Thigh

⊕ US exams for the evaluation of hip dysplasia, spine and spinal cord are also available in paediatrics.

Hand or Wrist

Prostate*

⊕ Prostate US only available if seen and recommended by a urologist or oncologist in the last 60 days.

Knee*

⊕ Knee US not available for non-specific conditions. Only in suspected issues with tendons or bursae, mass or cyst, nerve or collateral ligaments.

Skin and Subcutaneous Structures

⊕ Nurse Practitioners are unable to order MBS-reimbursible arterial or venous (doppler) ultrasounds.
